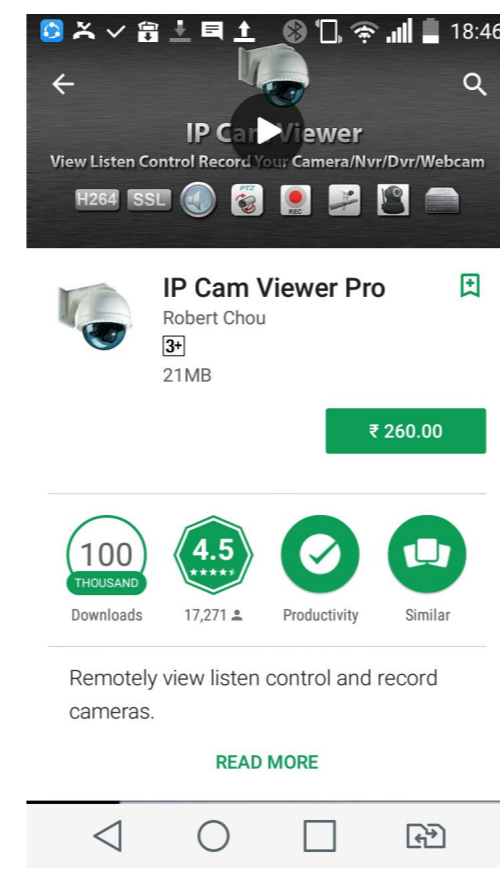
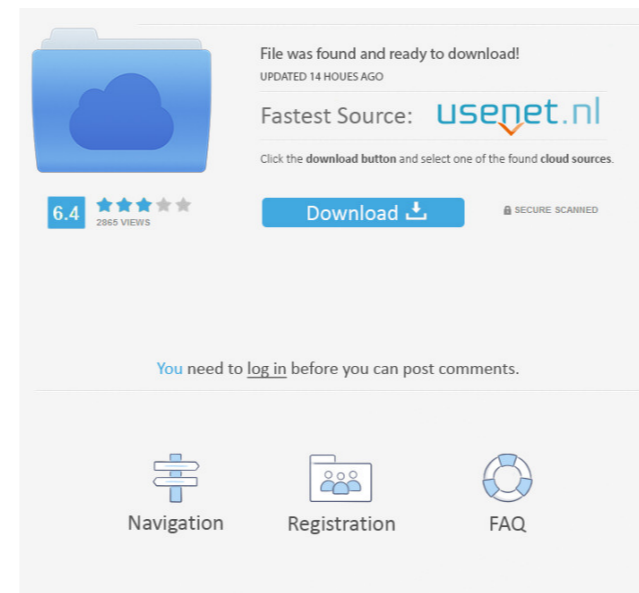

.net .mdf and .xml and SQL reports to users and other stakeholders through the Web interface of the web app. Once deployed, users can perform .mdf reports through Report Builder Management Console (RBM) and .xml reports through Report Builder Enterprise Administration Console (RBEE). Both the .mdf and .xml reports are delivered in the format of SQL Server Native Client (NCLI) .Net client. Reporting infrastructure Reporting in SQL Server is realized through SQL Server Agent. It is also possible to execute a Reporting Services report using SQL Profiler. SQL Server Management Studio (SSMS) is the primary tool for reporting. Report Builder contains a graphical report designer and more than 30 .Net controls and providers that can be used to create reports. Licensing Report Builder .Net is SharePoint Service Application on its own, the service application is considered a semi-closed application with internal security. Report Builder was initially released as a trial version and free software. According to Microsoft the trial version of Report Builder is only capable of executing, viewing and exporting MDF and XML reports that have been exported by other applications that may use Report Builder. Microsoft has not made a money-back guarantee on the use of the software as a trial version. The Report Builder requires a separate yearly subscription to use. There are two basic models for licensing a .Net application. The first model is per-seat licensing, with a subscription fee that covers usage for all users. The second is per-user usage, where the user will be billed for usage. The .Net application can be licensed to an enterprise through a Microsoft Software Assurance (SA) contract or directly through Microsoft Software Licensing for Microsoft products. Compatibility The version of Report Builder .Net supports MDF and XML reports. Support for other formats such as .pdf, .csv and others are in development. Reporting Services Reports can be run using SQL Server Agent, the Report Designer or from the Report Manager. The Report Manager is a feature that allows users to create, edit and schedule reports. Reports can also be generated in the Report Builder itself by using any of the many .Net controls and .Net providers that are provided. Report Builder .Net is only available for SharePoint Server 2013 and later versions.
